HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS FOR NACSA ANNUAL CONFERENCE (NACSACON) AS OF JUNE 2, 2022

Following are the NACSACon Health and Safety Protocols as of June 2, 2022. Please note that these NACSACon Health and Safety Protocols may be modified at any time prior to or during the NACSACon. NACSACon. NACSA will advise NACSACon attendees of any modifications.

- **Masks:** The required use of masks is determined by CDC guidelines, which are linked to county-specific indicators. Currently, the Hilton Minneapolis and Hennepin County do not require masks indoors. Consequently, masks are optional for all attendees. Masks will be available at registration if you request one. Attendees are encouraged to respect individual decision making with regard to masking.

- **Social Distancing:** Where possible, NACSA will provide extra seating if guests would prefer additional room to social distance. Social distancing may not be possible in workshop meeting rooms and some events due to space constraints. Social distancing stickers will be available at registration if attendees would like to indicate that they prefer more distance when interacting.
- **Hand-Sanitizer and Wipes:** Hand-sanitizer and disinfectant wipes will be available at registration and other meeting locations.
