Following are the NACSACon Health and Safety Protocols as of June 2, 2022. Please note that these NACSACon Health and Safety Protocols may be modified at any time prior to or during the NACSACon. NACSACon. NACSA will advise NACSACon attendees of any modifications.

Masks: The required use of masks is determined by CDC guidelines, which are linked
to county-specific indicators. Currently, the Hilton Minneapolis and Hennepin County
